### SPOTLIGHT // GRIEF & DIVORCE CARE

Sometimes, "Merry" is hard to come by. If you, or someone you know, is in the midst of grief and loss because someone you loved has died, or are currently separated or divorced there are emotions and experiences that are sometimes hard to describe, hard to process, hard to not get lost in and even lead you to question if you have "lost your mind". Oftentimes, this leads to a deep sense of loneliness, even when in a crowd of people (and can be especially magnified when at church!) This, along with whatever else might be felt, is normal to have in this incredibly difficult season of life.

*GriefShare* and *DivorceCare* are Christ-centered ministries of support and healing that are being offered separately beginning January 9th for anyone who is grieving the loss of a loved one -or- going through a separation or divorce -and- regardless of where individuals are in their faith journey or if they attend (any) church. Over the course of 13 weeks, participants will come together with the group facilitators to find support as they take steps toward the restoration of hope through healing.
