SPOTLIGHT // PRESCHOOL MINISTRY

Parenting kids in the pew on Sunday mornings isn't for the faint of heart yet is so important. The following tips might be helpful as your preschooler starts to spend more time in worship:

- Have a routine: pack a special big-church bag, borrow a worship bag with activities from an entrance to the sanctuary, or grab a kid's bulletin (they follow the sermon message).
- Sit near the front so your little one can see.
- Interact with your child during the worship service. You are not a distraction!
- Help your child follow the order of worship to find when to stand, sit, and go to Kingdom Kids.
- Help older kids find the scripture readings in the Bible and encourage them to listen to the prayers and sermon.
- Talk about the worship service during the week: download praise songs to sing in the car, talk about the sermon questions together, practice the Lord's Prayer at bedtime, read the Bible aloud.
- Stop worrying: we willingly and joyfully join in this great privilege of welcoming our covenant children into corporate worship. Remember, it's a commitment we made to your family when your little one was baptized!
