### SPOTLIGHT // VALUES

The 42nd General Assembly of the EPC met from June 21-24 in Northville, Michigan, and nine of your pastors, staff, and members attended. Our denomination's national gathering is always a joy to attend: there is excellent teaching and preaching, beautiful worship, encouraging stories from around our denomination, and important business. Below are a few of the highlights from the week:

- Our national leadership re-emphasized our denomination's commitment to sharing the good news, and throughout the week significant time was given in main sessions and workshops to equip local churches to have Gospel conversations in their everyday life.
- We elected Rosemary Lukens to serve as moderator of this year's General Assembly - the first female moderator in the history of our denomination.
- We approved the writing of a pastoral letter on racial lament and hope that will be drafted by a group of teaching and ruling elders from around the denomination and approved at a later meeting. This pastoral letter will join other letters our denomination has previously written on subjects such as human sexuality, domestic abuse, and the participation of children at the Lord's Supper.
- We commissioned a number of missionaries to service around the world. And our own Johnny Long was asked to serve on the World Outreach national committee!
- We approved a change in the way that the EPC requests support from local churches. This will not substantively change the amount that Signal Pres gives to the denomination.

We're grateful to be in the EPC and the blessings we receive from our connectional church.
