Last week, I (Scott) had the privilege to teach the 1st-3rd graders at our Wednesday night kid's discipleship. What a gift! It truly was like a melting pot of all our values, distilled down into one hour.

Biblical Authority: The lesson that night was on Exodus - part of a wider series that works kids through the entire the Bible over the course of a couple of years. The lesson instructed me to ask the kids what they talked about last week. To be honest, I had low expectations that anyone would remember, but I was pleasantly surprised to hear the depth of memory that the kids had of the passage.

Transformational Discipleship: Wednesday nights start out pretty wild (think 250 kids, wild). But what shocked me was that by the end of the night, kids had separated into dozens of small groups, and you could hear a pin drop. The transformation over the course of the night points to a deeper transformation that the Lord will do!

Generational Investment: Do you know how many adults it takes to lead all of those small groups? A hearty thanks to all of you who are investing in our kids!

Sacrificial Love: Do you know what those adults had done all day? Worked, parented, taught. But they showed up with energy and smiles. Do you know what lies behind our ability to host all of this? You...your giving, your willingness to give the entire building over to kids and students on Wednesday nights. Your sacrificial love is making a difference!

Missional Living: Behind all of this good work is a willingness on the part of the elders and others to do "whatever it takes" to ensure our kids encounter the gospel. That means taking some risks, doing some things differently, allowing for the mess and chaos that happens when 500+ students and kids crowd the building.
